

IV SVALARHEIMA DE EBRO MARCH 4TH AND 5TH, 2023, MIRANDA DE EBRO, BURGOS, SPAIN

One more time, the Asociación Juvenil Popocatepel and KWEN! bring back to Miranda de Ebro the, already classic, Svalarheima de Ebro tournament. For the fourth time we are organizing this great tournament for everyone that is looking to enjoy Infinity the Game among friends. And for the second time, Svalarheima de Ebro is a satellite tournament, so the winner would have a guaranteed seat at the Interplanetario 2023.

So, let's prepare your lists because this is getting exciting. It is going to be five Infinity rounds divided among two days where players would need to give the best of them if

they want to get the desired seat at Vigo...



INFINITY TOURNAMENT

The main event for the IV Svalarheima de Ebro will be the Infinity Satellite Tournament. Five rounds, 300 points on assorted missions, distributed among two intense days.

Date: March 2023, Saturday 4th and Monday 5th.

Place: La Fábrica de Tornillos (c/ Cantabria s/n, Miranda de Ebro, Burgos, España).

Tournament traits:

300 Points / 6 CAP

Misiones:

- » Frontline
- » Countermeasures
- » Decapitation
- » Quadrant control
- » Annihilation

Schedule:

Saturday:

9:30 receipt of the participating people

10:00/11:50 first round (Frontline)

12:15/14:05 second round (Countermeasures)

14:05/16:15 meal break

16:30/18:20 third round (Decapitation)

Domingo:

9:30 receipt of the participating people

10:00/11:50 fourth round (Quadrant control)

12:15/14:05 fifth round (Annihilation)

14:15 prize ceremony

The whole tournament will be regulated by the rules on the ITS Season 14 document, and both the lists and the miniatures must keep those rules.

This means: army lists elaborated only through the Infinity Army, printed lists (printed and certified lists will be provided to each player by the organization), mandatorily printed courtesy lists, painted lines of fire (referees are not there to determine where a miniature is looking at), proxy rules, use of the HVT miniature, etc.

Any problem generated by the inexistence of a painted LoF will be punished with 2 OP less for every game where this problem occurs.

In case of not having the courtesy list (the organization will provide only the private list, not courtesy lists) to show to the rival if he asks for it, the offender should show her rival the complete list, revealing on this way every Private Information.

Is each player's responsibility to carry enough needed miniatures to represent any HVT each mission requires (remember that they must represent what they are: civilians. Do not use miniatures carrying any kind of weaponry).

If a player does not place the HVT miniature or miniatures on the table when the missions requires it, it would be considered as if her rival had achieved to fulfil any classified objectives she has, even those that do not require interaction with a HVT miniature.

Also, remember that the ITS Season 14 rules 'Long service' and 'Tachimotos' will be applied.

Is responsibility of each player to read and understand how the missions work before the first day of the tournament and, in case of doubt, clarify them with the organization of the tournament also before the first tournament day.

Referees are there to make quick decisions about loopholes on the Infinity rules when these generate an argument between two players. If the players do not know how a rule works, they must check the rulebook, the annex or N4 FAQs (or the Infinity Wiki), and they should only turn to a referee if they are not capable of reaching an agreement. The resolution of the referee is a patch to make the game fluent, but it is final, must be accepted and applied until the end of the game.

Chess-clock will be mandatory only if one of the players requires it. In that case, the requiring player will be responsible of providing the chess-clock (real chess-clock, app...). Each player will have 50 minutes to choose classified objectives, deploy, play three turns and decide ARO.

Any control sheet given to the organization after the end of the round would be invalidated and it is up to the organization to decide how to manage those results.

For this tournament the players must use the Classified Objectives Deck on its extreme mode, that is: the red deck.

All the tables (or mostly all of them) will have special rules, such as dangers, movement or sight difficulties or other crazy things we came with depending on the terrain. Those rules are mandatory and must be applied by both players on each table.

LODGING

Given that it is an event divided on both days of a weekend and that some people would come from distant places, the organization body of the IV Svalarheima de Ebro wants to ease you the lodging and we propose you a very affordable option in the Fernán Gonzalez youth hostel, that is not too far away from La Fábrica de Tornillos (five minutes walking).

If for any reason you prefer any other lodgment option, feel free to search whatever fits better to your preferences.

We offer a room with breakfast in the Albergue Juvenil Fernan Gonzalez for one night (from Saturday to Sunday) or two nights (from Friday to Saturday and from Saturday to Sunday). Is not necessary to participate at the IV Svalarheima de Ebro to ask for lodging at the youth hostel.

The price of the youth hostel is 12€ per night.

To guarantee a place on the youth hostel is necessary to indicate at the moment of making the registration through the registration form, whether the lodging will be necessary or not, and if positive you must point out if you want lodging for one or two nights.

REGISTRATION, PAYMENTS AND DEADLINES

Everyone interested on participating on the Infinity tournament, must register themselves through the registration form at the end of the entry that will be published on October 2nd, 2022 on the blog of KWEN!. We will ease the link through diverse ways, such as the forums, WhatsApp or Telegram groups, Twitter, etc. To ensure a correct management of the registrations, we are only allowing the registration through the said method and before the announced deadlines.

The IV Svalarheima de Ebro Infinity Tournament will count with places for 60 players, so don't be lazy!

Deadlines of interest:

October 2nd: opening of the registrations (15:00 CET)

November 4th: closing of the registrations (15:00 CET)

November 5th: divulgation of the provisional and waiting lists

November 6th: start of the ordinary payments period (15:00 CET)

December 2nd: end of the ordinary payments period (15:00 CET)

Once this last date is passed, everyone on the provisional list that has not make the whole payment, will be placed at the end of the waiting list and the first person on the waiting list will occupy that place. Then the extraordinary periods will begin.

December 4th: divulgation of the updated lists

December 5th: start of the extraordinary payments period

December 30th: end of the extraordinary payments period

January 14th: start of sending the list through the OTM*

February 19th: last day to send the list through the OTM

*as said before, the organization will provide to each player a printed and certified copy of their lists, so it is very important to upload them to the OTM. The players must bring the courtesy lists printed (mandatory use) so they can control better what is shown on them, such as what happens with troops with holomask.

Payments:

Once the provisional list is divulgated, and later the updated list, those included on the lists will receive an e-mail with the instructions to follow to make the necessary payments through PayPal, Bizum or bank transfer.

To ensure a correct management of the payments, we are only allowing the payment through the said method and before the announced deadlines.

Once passed the end of the extraordinary payment period (and only if there are exceptional cases) we cannot guarantee the lodging to those interested on the youth hostel.

In case of retirement of any of the event activities, notifying it with a reasonable amount of time, the organization has the right to decide whether that person should receive a refund (partial or complete) or not, depending on how much time there is to the event and the options (tournament, contest, lodging) she has paid.

Not attending to the event (for those who have made the payment) entails the total loss of the payed amount.
